

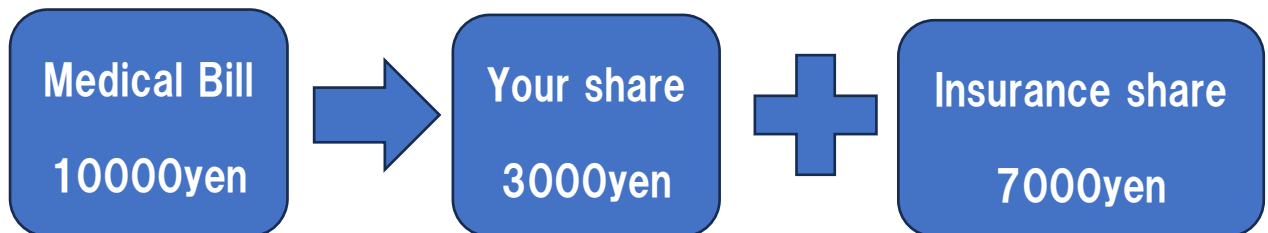
National Health Insurance Program Guide

Easy Guide to Japan's Health Insurance System

1. What is National Health Insurance?

- National Health Insurance helps everyone pay less when they go to the hospital.
- You pay only part of the cost.

e.g.

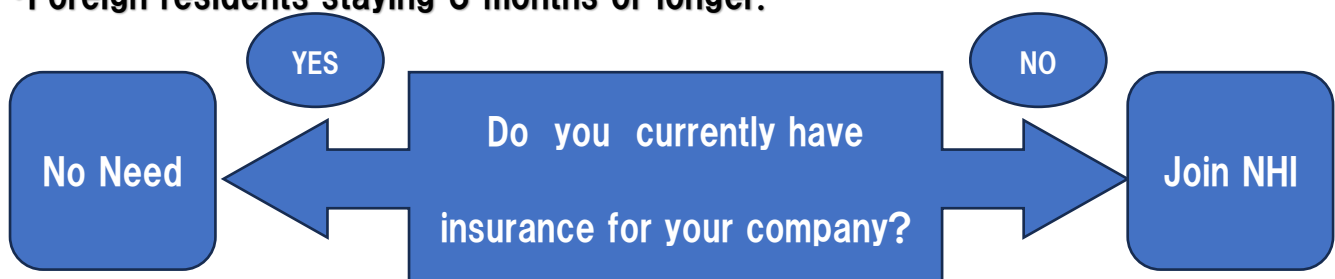


2. Who must join?

- People living in Japan who don't have company health insurance.

e.g. Students, part-time workers, self-employed persons

- Foreign residents staying 3 months or longer.



3. What is the National Health Insurance Tax?

Everyone shares the cost

- The tax amount depends on your income and household.
- Payment is usually divided into several installments per year.

4.How to Pay ?

e.g. Convenience Store

e.g. Smartphone Payment

- Town Hall Front Desk
- Convenience Store
- Financial Institution / Post Office
- Smartphone Payment App
- Automatic Bank Withdrawal
